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from the beginning of time humans have been driven by both a fear of the unknown and a curiosity to know we have always yearned to know what lies ahead whether threat or safety scarcity or abundance throughout human history our forebears tried to create certainty in the unknown by seeking to influence outcomes with sacrifices to gods preparing for the unexpected with advice from oracles and by reading the stars through astrology as scientific methods improve and computer technology develops we become ever more confident of our capacity to predict and quantify the future by accumulating and interpreting patterns from the past yet the truth is there is still no certainty to be had in this very short introduction jennifer gidley considers some of our most burning questions what is the future is the future a time yet to come or is it a utopian place does the future have a history is there only one future or are there many possible futures she asks if the future can ever be truly predicted or if we create our own futures both hoped for and feared by our thoughts feelings and actions and concludes by analysing how we can learn to study the future about the series the very short introductions series from oxford university press contains hundreds of titles in almost every subject area these pocket sized books are the perfect way to get ahead in a new subject quickly our expert authors combine facts analysis perspective new ideas and enthusiasm to make interesting and challenging topics highly readable

this is the first book length exploration of the ways art from the edges of the roman empire represented the future examining visual representations of time and the role of artwork in roman imperial systems this book focuses on four kingdoms from across the empire cottius s alpine kingdom in the north king juba ii s mauretania in the south west herodian judea in the east and kommagene to the north east art from the imperial frontier is rarely considered through the lens of the aesthetics of time and roman provincial art and the monuments of allied rulers are typically interpreted as evidence of the interaction between roman and local identities in this interdisciplinary study which explores statues wall paintings coins monuments and inscriptions readers learn that these artworks served as something more they were created to represent the futures that allied rulers and their people foresaw the pressure of roman imperialism drove patrons and artists on the empire s borders to imbue their creations with increasingly sophisticated ideas about the future as they wrestled with consequential decisions made under periods of intense political pressure comprehensively illustrated and providing an important new approach to roman material culture at the edge of empire visions of the future in roman frontier

kingdoms 100 bce 100 ce is suitable for students and scholars working on rome and its frontiers as well as roman material culture more broadly and those studying the aesthetics of time in art and art history

this book is an auto biography of trausti valsson an icelandic architect planner theoretician and a professor of planning at the university of iceland it gives a personal account of what shaped planning and design in the world and in iceland as he experienced it in his lifetime valsson e g tells about his personal encounter with ian mcharg buckminster fuller and christopher alexander early tv started working on a future plan for iceland consisting for example of roads connecting iceland s settlements across the central highlands he also started an overlay mapping project mapping both the hazard and resource areas of the country which created a basis for his iceland plan proposals work on this he continued at berkeley and at the university of iceland as he started teaching there in 1988 many of his articles and books deal with this subject in 1980 valsson started his phd studies in environmental planning at uc berkeley california in the philosophical section of his dissertation he presented his argument that the western mechanistic worldview was the underlying cause for today s alienation and that more holistic and integrative schemes were inherent in eastern worldviews tv s dissertation is called a theory of integration for design and planning based on the concept of complementarity 1987 in 1988 a year after valsson returned to iceland he got an associate professor position in planning at the engineering faculty of the university of iceland and later a tenured professor position the last part of this book describes valsson s 27 years at the university the title of this present book shaping the future ideas planning design reflects how wide valsson s field of his operation has been

temporal divergence creates a need for new narratives and paradigms in diverging time david carvounas supports this assertion through detailed expository and diagnostic readings of kant hegel and marx he focuses on their contribution to our understanding of modernity as an epochal shift in the relationship between past and future recasting the significance of the past and future of the modern present despite their different solutions to the problem of temporal coordination they urged the modern world to look not to the past but to the newly opened future for continuity meaning and purpose this book not only offers a fresh look at a defining characteristic of modernity but also makes a compelling case that a coherent modern temporal structure requires a sustainable orientation toward the future an orientation that kant hegel and marx delineate in distinctive and powerful ways
