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this second edition of the handbook of victims and victimology presents a comprehensively revised and updated set of essays bringing together internationally recognised scholars and practitioners to offer substantial research informed overviews within their specialist fields of investigation this handbook is divided into five parts with each part addressing a different theme within victimology part i offers a scene setting exploration of new developments in the field enduring issues that remain relatively unchanged and the gaps and traps within the contemporary victimological agenda part ii examines of the complex dimensions to victim experiences as structured by gender age ethnicity sexuality and intersectionality part iii reflects on the problems and possibilities of formulating policy responses in the light of the changing appreciation of the nature and extent of victimhood part iv focused on the value of a comparative lens and the problems and possibilities of victim policies when seen through this lens explored along three geographical axes europe australia and asia part v considers other ways of thinking about who counts as a victim and what counts as victimhood and extends the boundaries of the victimological imagination outward building on the success of the previous edition this book provides an international focus on cutting edge issues in the field of victimology including brand new chapters on intersectionality child victims sexuality hate crime and crimes of the powerful this handbook is essential reading for students and academics studying victims and victimology and an essential reference tool for those working within the victim support environment

this important new book on criminology is a major attempt to evaluate actual victim compensation programs as well as their political and economic contexts through the eyes of the victims themselves elias traces the experiences of violent crime victims throughout the entire criminal justice process comparing new york s and new jersey s victim compensation programs he shows how programs differ when compensation is viewed essentially as welfare and when it is viewed as a right the study uses extensive interviews with officials and with violent crime

victims the study indicates victim compensation programs largely fail to achieve their stated goals of improving attitudes toward the criminal justice system and the government the programs produce poor attitudes toward government and criminal justice

this work is the first interdisciplinary compilation of entries related to the crime victim to encompass the breadth of the 70 year old discipline of victimology the praeger handbook of victimology is the first full scale reference to encompass the full scope of the discipline of victim studies marking its evolution from an initial focus on homicide child abuse sexual assault and domestic violence to a more wide ranging modern interpretation that includes hate crimes terrorism and cyber crimes such as online bullying stalking and identity theft the praeger handbook of victimology offers an up to date portrait of its field including the latest research from criminal justice studies feminist studies and other disciplines as well as the changing views of the victim from law enforcement and the public at large the nearly 200 alphabetically organized entries cover everything from terminology unique to the field to victimizations relative to specific crimes to the extension of crime victim rights and victim interactions with the criminal justice system victims advocates legal professionals students researchers or anyone fascinated by the impact of crime on society will find this a uniquely informative resource

the study of victims of crime is a central concern for criminologists around the world in recent years some victimologists have become increasingly engaged in positivist debates on the differences between victims and non victims how these differences can be measured and what could be done to improve the victims experience of the criminal justice system written by experts in the field this book embraces a much wider understanding of social harms and asks which victims voices are heard and why mcgarry and walklate break new ground with this innovative and accessible book it offers a broad discussion of social harms the role of the victim in society and the inter relationship between trauma testimony and justice and asks how has harm been understood and under what circumstances have those harms been recognised how and under what circumstances are those harms articulated how and under what circumstances are the voices of those who have been harmed listened to each chapter draws on case studies and a range of questions designed to assist in reflection and critical engagement this book is perfect reading for students taking courses on victimology victims and society victims rights and criminal justice

many prosecutors and commentators have praised the victim provisions at the international criminal court icc as justice for victims which for the first time include participation protection and reparations this book critically examines the role of victims in international criminal justice drawing from human rights victimology and best practices in transitional justice drawing on field research in northern uganda luke moffet explores the nature of international crimes and assesses the role of victims in the proceedings of the icc paying particular attention to their recognition participation reparations and protection the book argues that because of the criminal nature and structural limitations of the icc justice for victims is symbolic requiring state parties to complement the work of the court to address victims needs in advancing an innovative theory of justice for victims and in offering solutions to current challenges the book will be of great interest and use to academics practitioners and students engaged in victimology the icc transitional justice or reparations

prior to the emergence of a victims movement in this country in the 1970s crime victims had only limited formal rights and remedies in the modern american justice system with the active encouragement of those involved in the victims movement and guidance supplied by a national task force on victims of crime

convened by president reagan in 1982 federal and state authorization of crime victim rights and remedies has increased exponentially in recent years in fact it has been estimated that there are currently tens of thousands of statutes which directly or indirectly affect crime victim rights and interests as well as victim related constitutional provisions in a majority of states tobolowsky describes the constitutional and legislative provisions addressing the principal crime victim rights and remedies and leading judicial opinions that have interpreted them in addition to presenting the current state of law in this area the text describes the status of implementation of these rights and remedies relevant empirical research and a sampling of the pertinent policy analysis this comprehensive portrait of the past and current status of crime victims rights and remedies in this country will inform the continued evolution of law and practice in this area

although historically ignored crime victims are now very firmly on the map for politicians newspapers the media and the public at large criminal injury and loss are a source of constant concern and anxiety criminologists and media analysts have studied much of this concern in recent years but what has not been investigated is how communities experience high profile crimes and the media intrusion that inevitably follows this book seeks to address this gap by exploring how the communities of soham and dunblane that witnessed high profile crimes lived with the tragic events at the time and the attention of the world s media afterwards based on a two year qualitative study of these communities this book looks beneath the surface of the relationships dilemmas and unexpected triumphs of communities struggling to come to terms with the most harrowing of events within the glare of the media spotlight combining empirical observations with media analysis and social theory this book offers something new to the criminological audience the concept of the victim community
